

ANNEX I EMERGENCY WATER SHORTAGE

I. SITUATION AND ASSUMPTIONS

A. Situation

Town of Thatcher may be confronted with a severe drought condition or contamination of wells that may result in a severe shortage of potable drinking water.

B. Assumptions

- i. Severe Water Shortages caused by a drought may cause several private and public well to go dry.
- ii. Contamination of Public or Private Wells may make the ground water in an area unfit for consumption.

II. MISSION

The Public Works Department in conjunction with Public and Private Water companies will work to provide 1st Potable Drinking Water to the residents of Town of Thatcher and 2nd work with the ranchers to provide water for livestock.

III. EXECUTION

A. Concept of Operations

1. Public Works will work to ensure that the drinking water meets or exceeds Federal EPA Standards. This will be accomplished by working closely with private and public water companies and private industries.
2. The Town Road Department will coordinate the transportation and delivery of both potable water and water for livestock.
